

DATA SHEET – AGRIMIN 24•7 CALCIUM BOLUSES

Presentation

A 210g Bolus containing 43g of Calcium.

Calcium Chloride 42%
Calcium Sulphate 34%

Calcium chloride dissolves rapidly, calcium sulphate is slow release.

Uses

Agrimin 24•7 boluses help to manage the calcium status of the herd during and after calving. The bolus dissolves and supplies calcium within 20 minutes of administration and has an active life of up to 36 hours.

Dosage and Administration

Pre and post calving regime: Administer one bolus per animal at the first sign of calving. Follow up with a second bolus 12-15 hours later if necessary.
On-farm recommendation – ‘If she’s got cold ears, she needs another bolus’

Post calving regime: Administer 1 bolus immediately after calving (or after sub-cutaneous calcium injection). Follow up with a second bolus 12-15 hours later if necessary.
On-farm recommendation – ‘If she’s got cold ears, she needs another bolus’

Agrimin 24•7 Calcium can be given to the following groups of livestock:

High yielding dairy cows.
Dairy cows with a previous history of calcium problems.
Older cows into their 3rd or more lactation.
Jersey and Guernsey cattle.
As a supplement to calcium injections after the treatment of milk fever.

Always use the recommended Agrimin bolus applicator.

Package Quantities

Agrimin 24•7 Calcium boluses are packed in units of 4.
There are 6 x 4 boluses in an outer.

Further information

Agrimin 24•7 Calcium dissolves completely in the reticulo/rumen.
The coating of the bolus protects against irritation of the epithelial surface of the throat and oesophagus. Furthermore, the bolus has a neutral taste, which makes it easy to administer.
