

DATA SHEET – 24·7 COPPER CATTLE

Presentation

A 31 g bolus containing 27 g of copper oxide rods, equivalent to 23 g of copper.

Uses

A dietetic complementary feed for the long-term supply of grazing cattle with copper. Agrimin **24·7 COPPER CATTLE** are long acting boluses for the oral administration of copper to cattle. They are designed to maintain normal copper levels over the whole grazing season (approximately 180 days).

Simultaneous supplementation of additives with a maximum content from other sources to those incorporated in a bolus, if applicable, shall be avoided.

Before using, it is recommended to have advice from a veterinarian or nutritionist concerning:

1. The balance of trace elements in the daily ration
2. The trace element status of the herd

Dosage and Administration

24·7 COPPER CATTLE is intended for:

Cattle under 100-250 kg – one bolus

Cattle over 250kg – one or two boluses

Always use the recommended Agrimin cattle bolus applicator B

Contra-indications, Warnings etc

Do not administer to pre-ruminant animals or to calves under 100 kg. No other form of copper supplementation should be given immediately prior to or 6 months after administration of the boluses. Do not exceed the recommended supplementation levels. Care should be taken when bolusing animals to avoid causing injury to the mouth and pharynx.

Pharmaceutical Precautions

Do not administer to cattle less than 100 kg.

Store in a cool, dry place

Reseal part used packs

Do not drop onto hard surfaces

Keep out of the reach of children

24·7 COPPER CATTLE are packed in units of 24 (enough for 24 cattle under 250 kg or enough for 12 cattle over 250 kg).
